It is run by a dedicated group of parents, as volunteers, who are committed in keeping a sense of culture, community, fun and fellowship.

- He received his classical ballet training at the Kharkiv Ballet School, specializing in Vaganova Ballet.
- While at Virsky Studio he furthered his classical ballet and dance training, attaining status of Ballet Master.
- Danced professionally, both as a revered soloist and cast member with the Ukrainian State Dance Company of Pavlo Virsky, for 17 years.
- In 1990, he participated in the creation of Ukrainian Folk Ensemble Hopak, Ukraine’s first independent professional dance company. With Hopak, he performed as a soloist, as well as, fulfilling the role of an instructor, for three years, prior to his arrival in Canada.
- Volodya has conducted many workshops across Canada and the United States.
- Volodya’s talent, wealth of experience and his “love of dance” benefits all ages.

# At Our Studio

- Ages 4 to adult.
- Club owned costumes and headpieces available for many different regional dances performed.
- Parents are required to provide Poltava blouse & slip/shirt, Hutzul blouse & slip/shirt, Hutzul pants/skirts and vests, for certain groups, as well as, all socks, footwear and practice attire.
- Vaganova (Russian) Ballet instruction for both boys and girls, beginning at the Junior level, incorporated into weekly dance class.
- Professional Studio - with mirrors, ballet barres and a 25’ X 50’ floating dance floor.
- Participate in performances and competitions throughout Alberta.
